Over these years, we have shifted some of the network's programs to meet these challenges. - x Our remote fellowships and teaching consultations, Immersive Technology Lab Consultations, and University Associates Program will continue with modifications and participation limits.

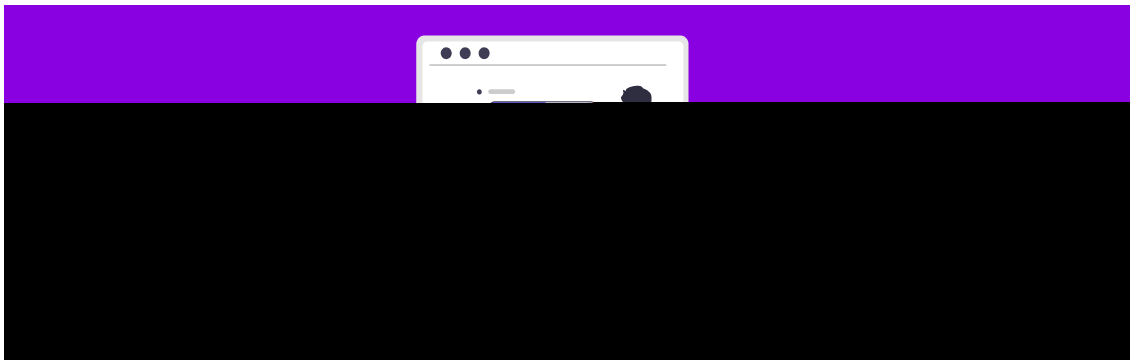
x The FRN Leadership Initiative and Digital Leadership Community of Practice will continue.
