Democratic incumbent Andy Kim's 3rd Congressional District was downgraded from "likely" to "leaning" in his favor over Republican Bob Healey in the most recent Cook Political Report that evaluates all of the country's House and Senate races.

"I think they've finally come around to seeing what many of us in New Jersey have seen, which is that this race is ge ting close," said Ben Dworkin, director at Rowan Institute for Public Policy and Citizenship.

He says there are a few keys to watch in this district, with turnout being the most important, and one town could ultimately decide the race.
