STAFFORD TOWNSHIP - Ocean County officiated and residents wereful wondering what happened Wednesday morning affeetv. Chris Christie's staff abruptly canceled a Hurricane Sandy recovery event af Manahawkin fire station.

The sudden change came alongsidvelations about his admitrization's involvement in the closing of access lanes onto the GeoMoreshington Bridge in Bergen County.

"The only thing I heard was he was on his way three was some kind effnergency and he had to turn around and go back Togenton," said John RSpodofora, the Republic mayor of Stafford Township, which includes Manahawkin.

He said he had no idea what the thratter was, and Christie spokes ple did not respond to emails asking to describe the emergency.

The governor's press office hadded the 11 a.m. event at Stafford Township Volunteer Fire Company No. 1 as a press conferenceingua "Sandy Housing ecovery Milestone Announcement with Homeowners."

Instead, people streamed outthose building over the next 15 minutes following the 10:24 a.m. cancellation, some audibly exposies disgust or disappointment.

"He's the governor, he nado what he wants," one man saidhestold another the event had been canceled.

The surprised attendees included Republican state Sen. Chris Connors and Republican Assembly members Brian Rumpfned DiAnn C. Gove, Spoof ora said. Connors an Rumpf did not respond to calls, but Gove said Stafford Townshipunoil members Henry Mandin Stephen Fessler and Sharon McKenna also were there.

Gove said she wasn't familiar with of the details, but said "oforse you're upset if it's true," adding "There's just disappointment there."

U.S. Rep. Frank LoBiondo, R-2nd, whom Cathine endorsed in the Statehouse on Monday, tweeted "I only know what (li)ead in papers. All facts should me out & confident (Christie) will take appropriate action."
