TOTAL ENROLLMENT

Total headcount for fall 2011 is 8,108 representing an increase of 229 (3%) students over last fall's total headcount of 7,879. Total FTE increased by approximately 356 (5%) to 7369.

NEW STUDENT ENROLLMENT

With regard to new undergraduates (freshmen and transfer/re-admits) in fall 2011:

There are 973 new freshmen and 1,142 transfer/re-admits. This represents an increase of 111 (13%) freshmen and a decrease of 14 transfer/re-admits for an overall increase of 100 (5%) new undergraduate students.
