**Galloway Township, NJ-** The Richard Stockton College of New Jersey will again offer its popular Crime Scene Investigation summer camp to high school students who want to gain hands-on experience in criminal investigation and trial preparation.

The camp will be hosted on the Stockton College campus and is open to the public, but space is limited. There are three sessions: July 5-9, July 19-23 and August 2-6.

With the help of people who work in criminal justice, law enforcement, and forensic psychology, campers will work as part of an elite team of investigators and professionals to help solve a murder. They will gain experience with evidence-gathering and evidence-testing techniques, such as DNA analysis, impressions, forensic odontology (bite mark evidence), ink analysis, fingerprints, chemical analysis, hair and fibers, blood typing, and spatter analysis.
