Galloway Township, NJ- The Richard Stockton College of New Jersey this summer will be hosting a group of young investigators — CSI campers — as they learn about crime scene investigation and courtroom techniques.

Dr. Joshua Duntley, associate professor of Criminal Justice, and Dr. Christine Tartaro, professor of Criminal Justice, expect the campers to gain an investigation including police reports, eye-witness interviews, fingerprinting, DNA analysis, jury selection and trial preparation.

"The campers watch the TV shows, so we tell them what's inaccurate and point out the myths and misconceptions," said Tartaro.
