Joseph is founding editor of the *Journal of Ethnicity and Criminal Justice*, which focuses on the challenges facing minorities in the criminal justice system. She has an impressive record of international and national service, including serving as the Academy of Criminal Justice Sciences (ACJS) representative to the United Nations in 2007. She became president of the ACJS in 2009, the first African American woman to hold the position.

In another matter brought before the Board, the College passed the first reading of a resolution approving the comprehensive review of College policies and procedures.
