## **Stockton Recruits Education Professionals To Incorporate Greek Culture Into the Classroom Through the Examined Life Program**

**GALLOWAY TWP., NJ** – Stockton College's Interdisciplinary Center for Hellenic Studies (ICHS) announces a new recruiting round for its Examined Life Program, a series of lectures, workshops and trips designed to help K-12 teachers introduce Greek culture into their classrooms.

Last spring teachers participated in the second round of this program from January through May, including a study trip to the University of Pennsylvania Museum of Art and Archeology and a ten-day trip to Greece. They learned about Greek history, culture, literature and art from a group of Stockton faculty, headed by Professors Mench and David Roessel.

This third round of the Stockton program will bring up to 20 new participants for a similar experience. Any K-12 teacher (or administrator) in South Jersey is eligible to apply, with preference given to those who have never been to Greece. There will be seven meetings on Wednesday evenings, from 6-9 P.M., plus three Saturday mornings and one Wednesday
