After Kristallnacht ("the night of broken glass") on Nov. 9-10, 193 targeted synagogues and Jewish homes and businesses, the present. Kristallnacht refers to the shards of shattered glass that lir of the attack. Eventually all Jewish businesses were sold, usually taken over by non-Jews, or closed.
