Galloway, NJ – Stockton College's Kramer Hall staff, students and faculty are making an effort to help the 1.3 million people in New Jersey who don't have enough to eat by holding a food drive.

The public is asked to bring canned goods and non-perishable staples to the food bins located in the lobby of Kramer Hall, 30 Front St. in Hammonton from **now** through **Nov. 27, 2013**.

Donated food will be given to the Community Food Bank of New Jersey, which distributes items to more than 1,000 charities throughout the state.

The most-needed items are: canned tuna, salmon, Spam, chicken, ham; condensed or powdered milk; pasta, potatoes, rice, cereal, boxed macaroni and cheese; canned chili, stews, meaty soups; peanut butter in plastic jars and canned fruit.
