Galloway , NJ - Enroll now for summer sessions starting in May and June at Stockton University. Taking summer courses is a way for students to save money, graduate sooner or to lighten their course loads during the fall and spring semesters.

A total of 288 courses, 150 of them totally online, will be offered at the Galloway main campus, at the Carnegie Center in Atlantic City, and at the Manahawkin, Hammonton and Woodbine instructional sites. Summer classes are open to students enrolled in degree programs, non-matriculated students and students currently enrolled at other institutions.

Students can save more than \$300 for each four-credit undergraduate course, and can take three classes for the price of two, if one course is at one of Stockton's instructional sites.

studying the children adds a deeper emotional connection to the material. Although the focus of the course is on the Jewish children's experiences, the course also considers the children of other victimized groups, including the German children of the Hitler Youth.

Among the many other topics students can explore this summer are courses on cyber-security, personal and consumer finance, leadership strategy and change, criminal justice, digital photography and the economics of tourism.
