Galloway, NJ - The Richard Stockton College of New Jersey will again offer its popular Crime Scene Investigation (CSI) summer camp to high school students who want to gain hands-on experience in criminal investigation and trial preparation.

The camp will be hosted on the Stockton College campus and is open to the public, but space is limited. There are four sessions: June 24-28, July 8-12, July 22-26 and August 5-9.

With the help of people who work in criminal justice, law enforcement, and forensic psychology, campers will work as part of an elite team of investigators and professionals to help solve a murder. They will gain experience with evidence--

that investigators utilize to learn the facts in a case, know when people are lying, and figure out when people's memories may be distorted. For the trial, campers will learn jury selection techniques, strategies for presenting their cases in a courtroom. They will also learn what life is like in jail for those individuals awaiting trial and life in prison for those people who are convicted.

The cost per student includes meals, room and board, classes led by professionals, and hands-on investigative and trial experience.
