In preparing the budgetead carefully the guidelines below. Awards or stiputs up to\$2,000.00 each are availablfor graduate students fipursuit of projects of a research and/or creative nature. Please note the Committee allocated a portion of the Uneisity \$\\$ budget each fiscal year and this allocation is variable and dependent or arious factors. While the typical project would involve one graduate student with one faculty advisor, graduate students rhyafo app joint research project conducted with multiput dentresearchers. In this case, multiple students working as part to a research team may have to share a spend. Each proposal is not guaranteed the maximum award, which \$2,000.00. If the mount of monies awarded is less than the proposed budget the student will need to decide wether to pursue the project or not an notify
