- \*Before transferring to Rutgers, students must complete 2 GAH, 1 GEN, 1 GIS, 1 GSS, 1 GNM and fulfill all attribute requirements. One GSS and one GNM will transfer back from Rutgers.
- <sup>1</sup>A grade of B or higher is required in order to be accepted by Rutgers.

- <sup>3</sup>May be taken at Rutgers.
- <sup>4</sup>Upper-level courses should only be taken if all transfer requirements have been met. These courses may count toward Stockton's BCMB degree requirements.
- A specific set of courses taken in the first year at Rutgers will transfer to Stockton to count toward the BCMB degree (18 program/cognate credits, 4 GSS credits, 4 GNM credits).
- Students should register for Stockton BIOL 4601 Pharmacy Seminar (0 credits) each semester after transferring to Rutgers until the Stockton BCMB degree is complete.
- Summer or part-time employment in a retail pharmacy setting is recommended as well as internships at pharmaceutical companies.
