Joseph Trout Hosts Middle School Students for a 'Day of Science'

Students from the St. Francis Xavier School in Philadelphia experienced a hands-on 'Day of Science,' which was hosted by Associate Professor of Physics Joseph Trout at Stockton University.

Trout, who lives in Philadelphia, also volunteers at the school managing their computer labs and repairing the computers.
