

University Status Survey Results as of Aphil 2014






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


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

The Student Senate Finance Committee submitted the Student Organization Budget for fiscal year 2015.

The budget approval process began with the facts given of additional new organizations whole process. This decision was made with facts given of additional new organizations requesting budgets, and no increase from the school Õs administration to be allocated. Therefore, the Finance Committee came tagmeement to thoroughly review every organization Õs spending patterns and financial history.

First the committee updated the budget proposal form, which was lead by committee member Vice ChairKiyle Osgood. The form was sent to every student orga**oizata** email. There was also a link to the form on the Student Senate and Student Development webpage. The organizations were then asked to submit the form to the committee via email.

Next, the committee reviewed the submitted forms, organizations to use to be alance, and past fiscal years budget allocations to all organizations. The committee also took into consideration the impact the organizations had at Stockton College this past fiscal year. Once the committee reviewed all financial infoion at feach organization, the committee then outlined meeting time slots for each organization. These meetings were to relay information to each organization of the state of their budget. It also helped the committee receive any additional input from the to the to the to the to the to the to the total input from the total to the total to the total to the total t

The committee then gathered any input from other senators, administration, and students. Their insight and guidance was greatly appreciated. After a week of intense studies and debates, the committee then convened **ferradized** the budget and submitted the outcome to each senate committee.

Overall 43 of the 68 incumbent organizations received moderate increases. 24 of the 68 incumbent organizations either received the same amount from fiscal year 2014, or received some type of a decrease. Only 1 of the 68 incumbent organizations did not receive a budget for next year. Lastly, there are 9 new organizations that that were qualified to receive a budget for fiscal year 2015.

In conclusion, there were many bumper by this process, and so many tough choices and decisions that were made. So the Finance Committee would like to thank every student organization for their patience and cooperation. We hope that the funds were allocated suitable to the students needs.
